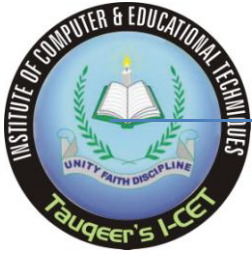

**22. A rolling Stone:**

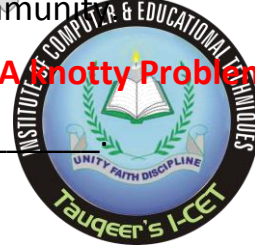
بے نتیجہ پیش قدمی
